- Can it be verified?

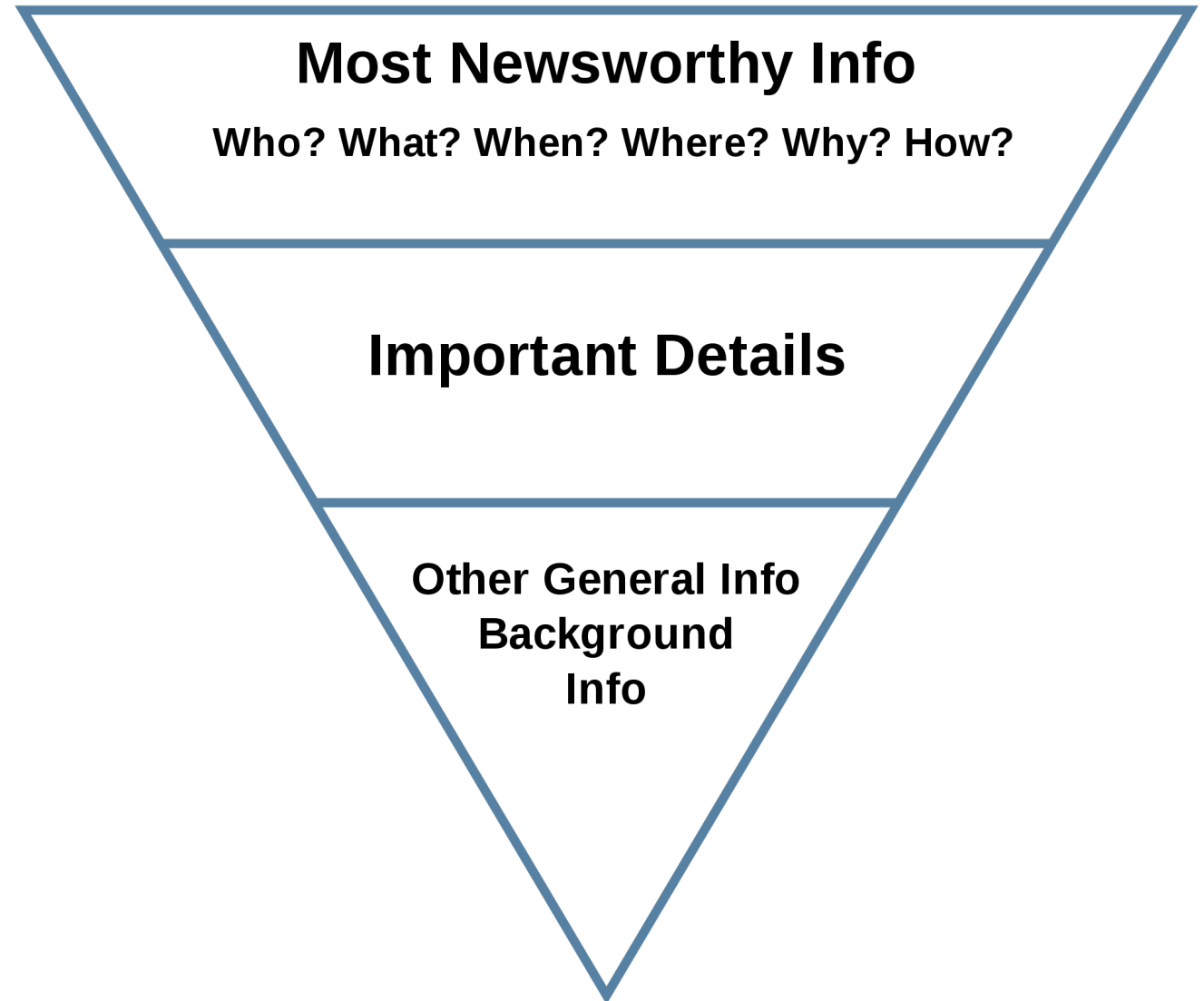
The more elements there are, the higher the news value.

Fire at Apartment Building Injures Two, Dozens Evacuated

A fire broke out at Green Valley Apartments early this morning, injuring two residents and forcing dozens of others to evacuate their homes. The fire, which started around 4:30 a.m., burned the third and fourth floors of the residential building located on Rue Samsenthai in Vientiane.

Local firefighters arrived quickly on the scene and were able to contain the blaze by 6:00 a.m., preventing it from spreading to nearby buildings. The two injured residents were transported to the central hospital, where their conditions are reported as stable.

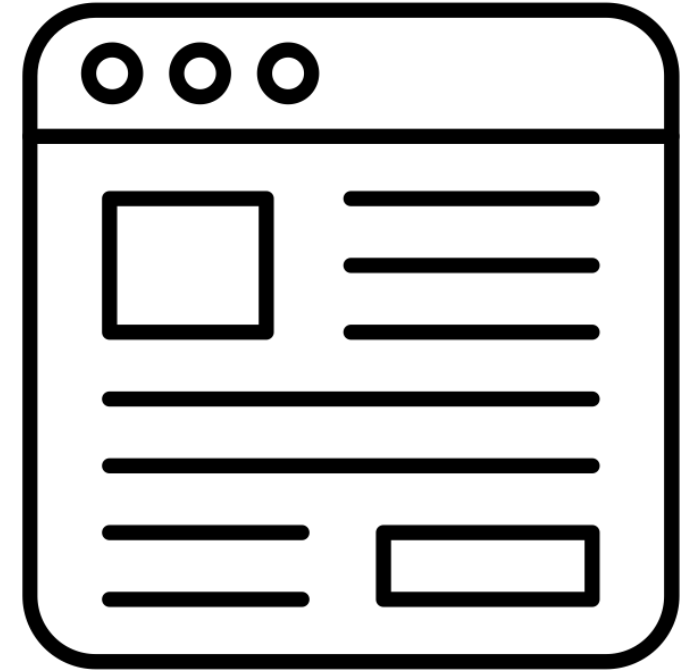
"We are lucky there were no fatalities," said Fire Chief Somchai Phommasack. "The fire was reported quickly, so our team could get people out of the buildings in time."

Authorities are investigating the cause of the fire. Early reports suggest an electrical fault may be to blame. Displaced residents have been relocated to shelters provided by local officials.

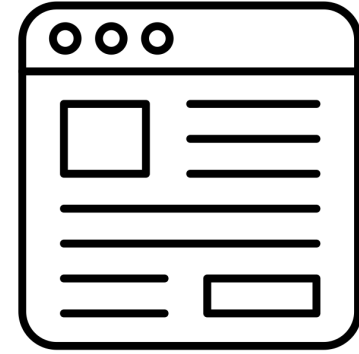

- The lead: the essence of the story, what's new
- First sentence has many of the 5ws and 1H
- Is factual, **not** opinion
- Is clear, easy to understand, uses everyday words, no unknown abbreviations

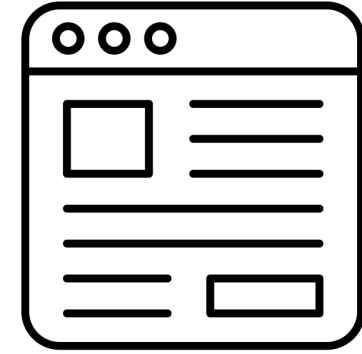
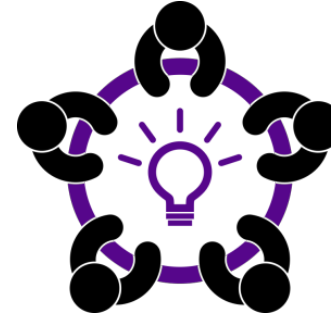
